Wednesday 28th September

On Wednesday, we will commence our topic on King Charles 111 – this will be a lead creative theme for the week. This topic will include arts, crafts, ICT and quizzes to name a few. Also on Wednesday, we will be having sports events on the school field.

Thursday 29th September

On Thursday we will be enjoying a morning of mini golf at Strokes Mini Golf at Westbrook. We will be leaving school at approximately 9.15am to walk to Strokes and will return in time for lunch. The children will also have the opportunity to choose an ice lolly before walking back to school. No additional money will be needed. - Ensure your child brings a spare bottle of water, especially if the weather is warm
- Ensure that your child is suitably prepared for walking in all weather conditions, as we know that our weather can be unpredictable. (Children will need comfortable shoes, sun cream, sunhat/cap and a raincoat)
