Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 4 Residential Trip Grosvenor Hall, Kingswood 26th to 28th April 2023

As you may be aware in April next year we are planning a residential trip for our Year 4 children to Grosvenor Hall in Ashford.

Grosvenor Hall is part of the Kingswood group for outdoor learning and the accommodation offers adventure and recreational facilities set in the grounds of a former manor house and allows for a very wide range of activities, all supervised by fully qualified instructors. We have used this site earlier this year for our previous year 6 children and both the accommodation and facilities are of a high standard.

We will be holding a meeting on **Wednesday 5th October** to give further information for both parents and carers of children who may have already booked or for families who would be interested in taking part. During the meeting there will be a presentation regarding the location and all that it offers and a chance to speak with staff who have attended previously. The meeting will be at 6:15pm on 5th October and will be held in the KS2 hall. Entry will be via the main entrance on Westfield Road.

The cost of the trip will be £175.00 and a deposit of £50 will be required to secure a place for your child. Further information regarding the schedule of payments and how to pay via Weduc will be sent to you on the day of the meeting. Parents and carers need to be aware that deposits are non-refundable and in the event you wish to cancel your child's place you will be liable for cancellation charges. If you have already booked and paid a deposit for your child, there is no obligation to attend the meeting.

We would like to take as many children as possible, but places are limited, and can only be guaranteed on a first come first served basis on the payment of a deposit.
