At this stage of year 5, children of 'average' mathematical and reading ability should be working at band 29 or 30. They should also have an approximate <u>standardised</u> score of 100. However, those looking to secure places in grammar schools should ordinarily be already working at, or above, band 31 and have an approximate <u>standardised</u> score of 110 or above.
